The Rhode Island Department of Transportation (RIDOT) operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, and national origin (including Limited English Proficiency) in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

Any person who believes she or he has been discriminated against by RIDOT, MBTA (South County Commuter Rail), or Seastreak (Providence-Newport Ferry) may file a discrimination complaint with RIDOT within 180 days of the alleged discriminatory conduct by contacting:
