The documents may be reviewed at the Rhode Island Department of Transportation, Two Capitol Hill, Providence, Rhode Island from FEBRUARY 28, 2017 to MARCH 28, 2017 between the hours of 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM Monday through Friday, by appointment only.

**PUBLIC HEARING:**

A public hearing on the Annual Report or Revised Plan will be held if RIDOT receives such requests from twenty-five (25) people, a government agency or subdivision, or an association having not less than twenty-five (25) members. If a public hearing is to be held, a public notice will be published announcing the date, time, place of such hearing, and the deadline for submitting written comments.

**PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD:** (FEBRUARY 28, 2017 to MARCH 28, 2017)

All comments on the documents should be submitted in writing or via email post-marked no later than 4:00 PM on MARCH 28, 2017. If, during the public comment period, significant new questions are raised concerning the document, DOT may require a new draft or may reopen the public comment period. A public notice will be issued for any of these actions.

**FINAL DECISION AND APPEALS:**

Following the close of the comment period, and after a public hearing, if such hearing is held, the Director will issue a final decision and forward a copy of the final documents to RIDEM and each person who has submitted written comments or requested notice.
