1. Chester from East Providence – Inverted Signage, just south of Route 1A (Newport Avenue) in East Providence

Our Maintenance crews went out to the area but did not come across what Chester had described. However, we had corrected an inverted sign prior to Chester's call just over a week ago on Newport Avenue at Beverage Hill Avenue. That may be the sign that Chester saw.

2. AJ from North Providence – Highway Signs with Down Arrows on I-95 South at the Providence Viaduct in Providence

We appreciate AJ's comments on highway signs with up versus down arrows. The down arrows are working really well on the Viaduct so we are going to leave them as they are. As you know, we follow guidelines from the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) and our arrows are in compliance and seem to be very effective.

3. John from Warwick – Traffic Signal on Route 1 and Ann & Hope in Warwick

Our Traffic engineers conducted a field visit and found that the signals are working properly. But, the system dates back to when Ann & Hope was in full operation and much more traffic drove in and out of the parking lot. We are going to reach out to the owners and to the City to see if together we can come up with a more modern solution that works for all parties.
