A. REPORTING SELF-VERIFICATIONS

A submission of a Self-Verification Notification Form (SVNF) and supporting documentation to the Army Corps is required for projects which are under RIDEM jurisdiction and fall under GP's 1-21 or are under CRMC jurisdiction and fall under GPs: **6, 9, 10, 12, 13, 16, 18, 19, 21**. The Rhode Island Department of Transportation shall submit the following checklist with the Army Corps Self-Verification Notification Form (SVNF) to the RIDOT Natural Resources Unit (NRU) with "Army Corps RIPGP Application: [Project Title and PTSID]" in the subject line. Submit SVNF materials to the NRU only after a RIDEM or CRMC application has been submitted and a file number has been assigned. The RIDOT NRU will submit the SVNF and supporting materials to the Army Corps immediately following an application submission to RIDEM/CRMC. For those materials that do not apply, do not select.
